With the growing interest in sustainability and other environmental-related issues, the number of LEED-certified projects our team has worked on has grown significantly over the last three to five years. Because of cost constraints, many schools cannot afford to pursue LEED Gold certified buildings but we work closely with clients to include as many LEED certified elements as possible in our designs so that certification could be pursued in the future. Examples of this include energy efficient equipment, variable fan drive motors to modulate the speed of exhaust fans, food pulpers and more.
